**SUBJECT: Proposed Items for Purchase from the State Seizure Account #SA22/23-350-01**

The following items are proposed for purchase from the State Seizure account:

1. Service Pistol Replacement \$150,000

On March 21, 2022, Council approved the multi-phased replacement of all current service pistols via State Seizure Amendment SA21/22-350-03. This request is for the approval of another round of replacements which includes new pistols, lights, iron sights, duty holsters, optics, and ammunition for training that will be associated with the new RDS platform. The current issued Glock 17 Gen 3 pistols have been in service since 2006. It has been recommended from Glock that these pistols be taken out of service or be completely overhauled by replacing all the internal parts and barrels. Due to the age and round count, this is not a cost-effective option. Replacing all service pistols with the Glock Gen 5 MOS will eliminate the need for various gun parts for the previous models issued. This will also streamline the transition to RDS capable weapons.

2. Global Positioning for Police Radios \$20,000


On October 4, 2021, Council approved the purchase/activation of global positioning for police radios in the amount of \$55,000 via State Seizure Amendment SA21/22-350-01. This request is for an additional \$20,000 due to additional Police radios required because of anticipated progress on Police staffing levels. The activation of the Astro Radio Location Interlace feature of the radio system will allow for the location of an individual portable radio, and thereby the first responder using it, to be determined in real time. First responders frequently engage in the most dangerous aspects of their jobs outside of and at distance from their squad cars or other means of geolocation and this technology will greatly aid in keeping them safe.


