## SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT NO. 7 TO THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN STAR TRANSIT AND THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS

THIS SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT NO. 7 to that certain Interlocal Agreement executed on September September 19, 2016, as amended by Supplemental Agreement No. 1 executed on September 19, 2019, Supplemental Agreement No. 2 executed on September 23, 2020, Supplemental Agreement No. 3 executed on September 13, 2021, Supplemental Agreement No. 4 executed on November 3, 2022, Supplemental Agreement No. 5 executed on September 22, 2023, and Supplemental Agreement No. 6 executed on September 30, 2024, ("Agreement") by and between the CITY OF MESQUITE, a Texas home rule municipal corporation, located in Dallas and Kaufman Counties, hereinafter called "CITY," and STAR TRANSIT, a Texas Rural Transit District, authorized by Texas Transportation Code, Chapter 458, hereinafter called "STAR Transit," evidences the following:

- 1. Effective October 1, 2025, the CITY and STAR Transit hereby agree to replace Exhibit A-1 of the Agreement with Exhibit A-1 attached hereto, which is fully incorporated for all purposes.
- 2. All other terms, provisions, conditions, and obligations of the Agreement between CITY and STAR Transit shall remain in full force and effect and said Agreement and together with Supplemental Agreement No. 1, Supplemental Agreement No. 2, Supplemental Agreement No. 3, Supplemental Agreement No. 4, Supplemental Agreement No. 5, Supplemental Agreement No. 6, and this Supplemental Agreement No. 7 should be construed together as a single contractual agreement.

Dear Mayor Aléman,

As you may know our FY26 cost of service for all public partners has been established by the Board at \$58.50 per hour of transit service. Each jurisdiction will contribute the amount necessary to cover their average number of hours of service each day, less any off-setting grants, contracts that may be used to earn revenue or reduce costs in that specific jurisdiction.

Those off-sets vary greatly by jurisdiction due to funding rules and local conditions. Funds available from non-local sources pay for the vast majority of STAR Transit's capital and operating costs. This letter provides guidance in Exhibit A-1 on how this policy will impact Mesquite's total cost of service for FY26.

Please expect our FY26 cost of service to vary dependent on any changes in our hourly cost of service, grant availability and other local factors. We look forward to serving the City of Mesquite.
