A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, ENDORSING AND ACCEPTING THE 2021-2022 IMPAIRED DRIVING MOBILIZATION GRANT FOR THE SELECTIVE TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT PROJECT; APPROVING THE CONTRIBUTION OF CITY FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,532.73; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE NECESSARY DOCUMENTS WITH THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION IN CONNECTION WITH SUCH GRANT AND PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the City of Mesquite, Texas (the "City"), and the Texas Department of Transportation ("TxDOT") cooperatively participate in a Selective Traffic Enforcement Project to promote highway safety (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the Project for 2021-2022 will be funded in part by an Impaired Driving Mobilization Grant from TxDOT in the amount of \$5,945.14 and in part by City funds in the amount of \$1,532.73; and

WHEREAS, the grant from TxDOT and the contribution of City funds will provide funding to hire officers on an overtime basis to detect and apprehend intoxicated and impaired offenders on the City's roadways for Fiscal Year 2021-2022.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the City of Mesquite, Texas, hereby endorses and accepts the 2021-2022 Impaired Driving Mobilization Grant for the Selective Traffic Enforcement Project (the "IDM-STEP Grant") from TxDOT.

SECTION 2. That the contribution of City funds in the sum of \$1,532.73 for the Project is hereby approved.

SECTION 3. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute the necessary documents in connection with the Project including, without limitation, all documents necessary for the purpose of requesting, receiving and dispensing funds through TxDOT for the IDM-STEP Grant.
