Body

A list of tax-foreclosure properties available for sale is posted on the City's website. The City received an offer of \$15,000.00 on the unimproved property located at 34 Forest Creek Circle.

The offer fell under Texas Tax Code §34.05(i). A sale under this code requires the purchaser to pay the post-judgment taxes, penalties and interest to the taxing entities and requires the consent of all taxing units entitled to processed from the sale.

The approximate amount of the post-judgment taxes, penalties and interest is \$3,834.41.

Mesquite Independent School District's Board of Trustees approved the sale on August 14, 2017. The Dallas County Commissioners Court approved the sale on September 5, 2017, with their Court Order 2017-1123.
