New Mesquite Rodeo owner and president of Centurion American Development Group Mehrdad Moayedi presented the City Council with his vision for Iron Horse Village, a development set to be located near the Mesquite Rodeo.

The proposed project is a mixed-use community on 54 acres that would consist of 318 single-family residential home sites, 169 rear-entry townhomes, 38 front-entry townhomes, 57 detached urban homes, 24 single-family detached bungalows and 30 single-family detached villas.
