





| <p>The police range is currently being upgraded, and a portion of the planned improvements will include a new barrier wall. HESCO, military style barricades will be used to line the areas where the new walls will be placed. This type of barrier is simpler and less expensive than solid concrete options. It offers good protection at less cost.</p> | | |
| 2. | Fill material for barriers | \$30,000 |

| <p>The HESCO barrier product being purchased for the range upgrades requires fill material to be placed into each barrier.</p> | | |
| 3. | Fatal Vision Equipment | \$1,500 |

| <p>The Mesquite Police Department utilizes the Citizens Police Academy (CPA) to operate its Fatal Vision Program. This program is used to demonstrate the reduced driving abilities associated with driving while impaired. The CPA deploys the equipment throughout the year reaching numerous youths and adults. The current equipment has exceeded its service life and staff recommends replacement of the equipment. This equipment will be used at community events to teach citizens (especially teens) the dangers of impaired driving and to emphasize safe driving habits.</p> | | |


