A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, APPROVING THE FORM AND AUTHORIZING THE DISTRIBUTION OF A PRELIMINARY LIMITED OFFERING MEMORANDUM FOR THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, SPECIAL ASSESSMENT REVENUE BONDS, SERIES 2019 (IRON HORSE PUBLIC IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT PROJECT); AND RESOLVING OTHER MATTERS INCIDENT AND RELATED THERETO.

WHEREAS, the Public Improvement District Assessment Act, Texas Local Government Code, Chapter 372, as amended (the "PID Act") authorizes the City of Mesquite, Texas (the "City"), to create a public improvement district; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 15-2019, adopted by the City Council of the City (the "City Council") on February 4, 2019, the City has created the "Iron Horse Public Improvement District" (the "PID"); and

WHEREAS, MM MESQUITE 50, LLC, a Texas limited liability company, intends to develop property within the PID; and

WHEREAS, the City intends to issue bonds to be designated "City of Mesquite, Texas, Special Assessment Revenue Bonds, Series 2019 (Iron Horse Public Improvement District Project)" (the "Bonds") to fund certain improvements in the PID as authorized by the PID Act; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has been presented a Preliminary Limited Offering Memorandum relating to the Bonds (the "Preliminary Limited Offering Memorandum"); and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that it is necessary and in the best interests of the City to approve the form and content of the Preliminary Limited Offering Memorandum and authorize the use of the Preliminary Limited Offering Memorandum in the offering and sale of the Bonds by the Underwriter of the Bonds, FMSbonds, Inc., under the conditions outlined herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the form and content of the Preliminary Limited Offering Memorandum is hereby approved with such changes, addenda, supplements or amendments as may be approved by the City Manager.

SECTION 2. That the City hereby authorizes the Preliminary Limited Offering Memorandum to be used by FMSbonds, Inc. (the "Underwriter"), in connection with the initial marketing and sale of the Bonds; provided that such Preliminary Limited Offering Memorandum shall not be released to the public without the approval of the City Manager, which approval shall be made in consultation with Hilltop Securities, Inc., the City's Financial Advisor, and Bracewell, LLP, the City's Bond Counsel.

SECTION 3. That the City Council hereby delegates to the City Manager the authority to approve release of the Preliminary Limited Offering Memorandum to the public for use in marketing the Bonds under the conditions outlined herein.

SECTION 4. That City staff is authorized and directed to do all things proper and necessary to carry out the intent hereof.

SECTION 5. That this Resolution shall become effective from and after its date of passage in accordance with law.
