AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, CREATING A NEW APPENDIX D TO THE MESQUITE CITY CODE, ENTITLED "THE COMPREHENSIVE FEE SCHEDULE," THEREBY ESTABLISHING A PLACE WHERE ALL FEES FOR CITY SERVICES ARE LOCATED; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING A REPEALER CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED \$2,000.00; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the fees for various City services are currently scattered throughout the Mesquite City Code, as amended (the "Code"); and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to make fees more easily accessible to citizens by creating one location for all fees by moving existing fees to a new Appendix D, "The Comprehensive Fee Schedule," to the Code; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance creates Appendix D to the Code and a companion ordinance removes fees from Chapters of the Code and makes reference to their new location in Appendix D.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

- <u>SECTION 1</u>. That Appendix D entitled "The Comprehensive Fee Schedule" of the Mesquite City Code, as amended, attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and made a part thereof, is hereby created and establishes a place where all fees for City services are located, in all other respects said Code to remain in full force and effect.
- SECTION 2. That all ordinances or portions thereof in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance, to the extent of such conflict, are hereby repealed. To the extent that such ordinances or portions thereof are not in conflict herewith, the same shall remain in full force and effect.
- SECTION 3. That should any word, sentence, clause, paragraph or provision of this ordinance be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.
- SECTION 4. That, unless specifically provided otherwise by this ordinance or by state law, any person (as defined in Chapter 1, Section 1-2 of the Mesquite City Code, as amended) violating any of the provisions or terms of this ordinance governing fire safety, zoning, or public health and sanitation, shall be deemed to be guilty of a Class C Misdemeanor and, upon conviction, shall be subject to a fine not to exceed \$2,000.00, and that any person (as defined in Chapter 1, Section 1-2 of the Mesquite City Code, as amended) violating any other provision of this ordinance shall be deemed to be guilty of a Class C Misdemeanor, and, upon conviction, shall be subject to

a fine not to exceed \$500.00. If the maximum penalty provided for by this ordinance for an offense is greater than the maximum penalty provided for the same offense under the laws of the State of Texas, the maximum penalty for violation of this ordinance for such offense shall be the maximum penalty provided by the laws of the State of Texas.

SECTION 5. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after five days after publication.
