A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF STATE HIGHWAY 352 ON JANUARY 18, 2020, FOR THE CITY OF MESQUITE MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. PARADE.

WHEREAS, the City of Mesquite (the "City") is planning the annual Martin Luther King, Jr. parade (the "MLK Parade" or "Parade") in downtown Mesquite on January 18, 2020, commemorating the anniversary of the birth of Martin Luther King, Jr.; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to honor the life and achievements of Martin Luther King, Jr., and encourage the economic vitality of the City, and in connection therewith recognizes the value of the Parade in achieving these goals; and

WHEREAS, Main Street and Davis Street are the eastbound and westbound legs of State Highway 352 through downtown Mesquite; and

WHEREAS, the Texas Department of Transportation ("TxDOT") will allow the temporary closure of Main Street and Davis Street for the Parade upon execution of an agreement for the temporary closure of State right-of-way between TxDOT and the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Council of the City authorizes the City Manager to execute an agreement between TxDOT and the City for the temporary closure of a portion of State Highway 352 (also known as Main Street and Davis Street) between Bryan Belt Line Road and Ebrite Street, on January 18, 2020, for the Parade.
