

Police Department Quarterly Report

FY 2020 Quarter 3 (April- June)



The Police Department Quarterly Report lists current staffing levels, NIBRS crime reporting, Police Performance Metrics, and other updates. This is a high level overview on performance for the past quarter and any additional information or breakdowns can be requested. In this quarter, most crime metrics continue to trend downward and an emphasis on sharing traffic enforcement data is made available.

Staffing

- MPD Staffing- Below list numbers of open positions followed by total. The new physical agility test for police officer positions is now in effect.
 - Police Officer- 9/239
 - 4 police officers have announced their retirement
 - Public Safety Dispatcher- 5/34
 - Detention Officer- 1/22
 - Administrative Law Enforcement Coordinator- 1/5
 - Records Clerk- 1/9

NIBRS Crime Reporting

- MPD Calls for Service are down approximately 13% from the same time period last year.
- Total NIBRS Crime (YTD thru June) is down approximately 22% from our 2019 level. This would be about an 11% decrease in UCR data (because UCR tracks only 7 categories).
 - Robbery, Theft (shoplifting, BMV and from buildings) and Burglary are down
 - Shoplifts and Thefts from Buildings decreased substantially in the last quarter due to COVID shutdowns

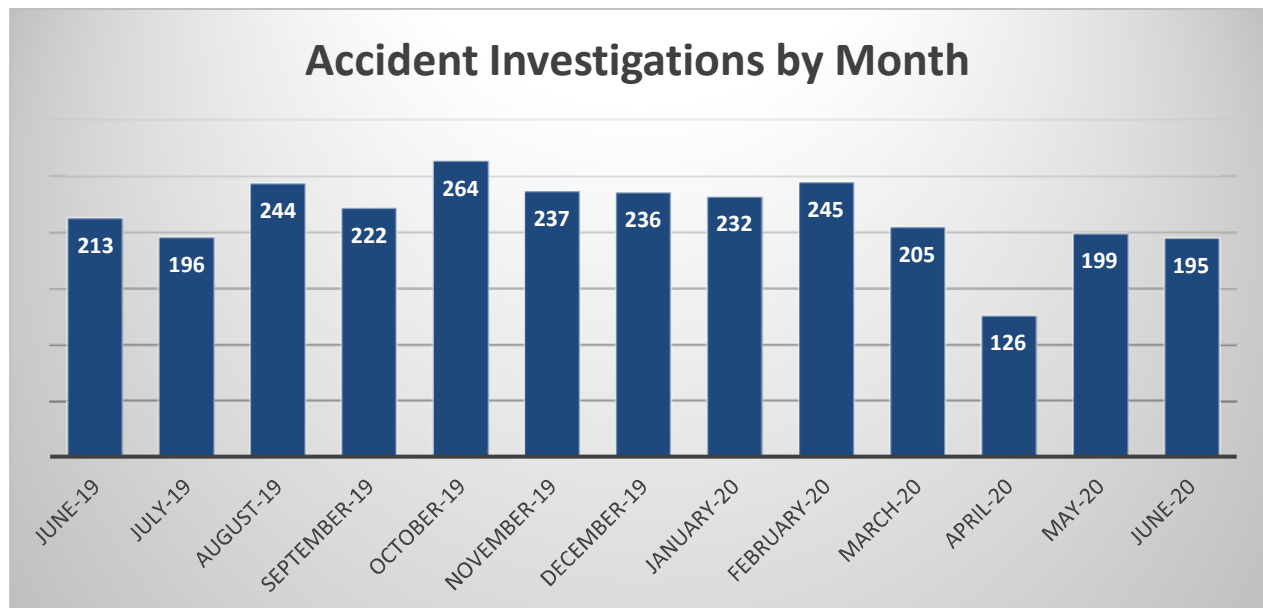
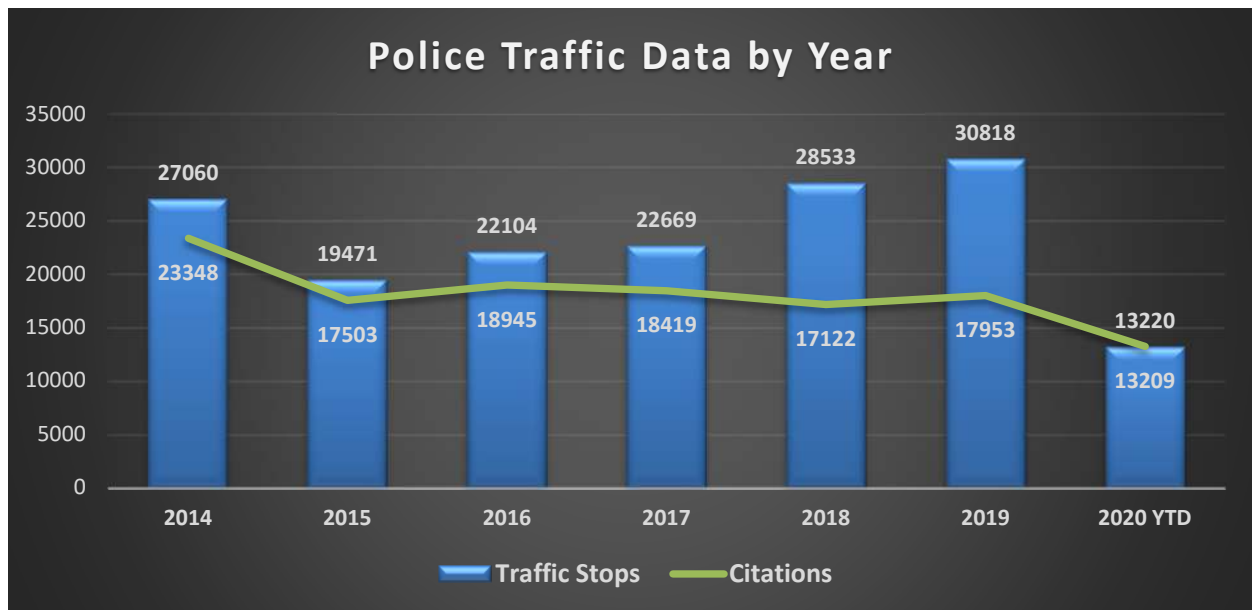
MPD Performance Metrics by Quarter

Traffic Enforcement Data

- Traffic enforcement remains a key focus area, as transportation patterns have seen less traffic on the street, which might encourage speeding. Police has not seen an uptick in accidents and Police citations are on par with last year's amount.



- Traffic Officer Division
 - 5936 out of the 13209 (46%) 2020 YTD citations have been written by the Traffic Division
 - 144 out of 1355 (11%) 2020 YTD accidents have been investigated by the Traffic Division
