

RESOLUTION NO. _____

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, EXPRESSING INTENT TO
REIMBURSE EXPENDITURES FROM PROCEEDS OF
FUTURE OBLIGATIONS.

WHEREAS, the City of Mesquite, Texas (the “City”), is a municipal corporation and political subdivision of the State of Texas authorized to finance its activities by issuing obligations; and

WHEREAS, the City will make, or has made, not more than 60 days prior to the date hereof, payments with respect to the design, engineering, acquisition, construction, reconstruction, or renovation of the projects listed on Exhibit A attached hereto (collectively, the “**Financed Project**”); and

WHEREAS, the City has concluded that it does not currently desire to issue obligations to finance the costs associated with the Financed Project; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to reimburse itself for the costs associated with the Financed Project from the proceeds of obligations to be issued subsequent to the date hereof; and

WHEREAS, the City reasonably expects to issue obligations to reimburse itself for the costs associated with the Financed Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. The City reasonably expects to reimburse itself for costs that have been or will be paid subsequent to the date that is 60 days prior to the date hereof and that are to be paid in connection with the acquisition, construction, reconstruction, or renovation of the Financed Project from the proceeds of obligations to be issued subsequent to the date hereof.

SECTION 2. The City reasonably expects that the maximum principal amount of obligations issued to reimburse the City for the costs associated with the Financed Project will be \$47,500,000.

SECTION 3. Unless otherwise advised by bond counsel, any reimbursement allocation will be made not later than 18 months after the later of (1) the date the original expenditure is paid or (2) the date on which the Financed Project to which the expenditure relates is placed in service or abandoned, but in no event more than three years after the original expenditure is paid.



DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT

<u>Purpose/Project</u>	<u>Amount</u>
Designing, developing, constructing, improving, extending, and expanding streets, thoroughfares, sidewalks, alleyways, and bridges, including renovating and equipping street lighting, right-of-way protection, streetscaping, related storm drainage improvements, traffic signals, traffic congestion relief, and paving improvements;	\$20,000,000
Improvements to existing City Facilities, including fire facility improvements, library improvements, airport improvements, service center improvements and field services	\$1,500,000
Equipment and vehicle replacement for various city departments, including public safety and emergency services, neighborhood services and city administrative services	\$6,000,000
Designing, developing, constructing, improving, extending, and expanding the City's water and wastewater system.	\$18,000,000
Designing, developing, constructing, improving, extending, and expanding the City's drainage utility system.	\$2,000,000
