The Council has been briefed on a pending application for development of 25.464 acres, proposed to be developed with retail uses. The area is currently in the City's extraterritorial jurisdiction. Annexation of the subject property is voluntary and necessary before it can be zoned for development.

Proper notice of the proposed annexation was provided and two public hearings were held as required by law.

The annexation ordinance adopts a service plan, which constitutes a contract with property owners for the provision of municipal services.
