The bid is for the purchase of miscellaneous replacement parts which are purchased on an as-needed basis throughout the year. The bid prices are based on dealer's cost plus a percentage of markup. It is anticipated that a total of \$51,000.00 will be spent on replacement parts during the next year. The term of this contract is for one year, with four additional one-year renewal options. The City Manager is authorized to exercise the renewal options, subject to annual appropriation of sufficient funds.
