(1) Mesquite Police Department SWAT Equipment Enhancement (Night Vision Goggles) (Grant Number: 3551001) - will enhance the Tactical Team's ability to operate in low light or no light conditions to protect officers and citizens when dealing with coordinated and complex terrorist attacks, hostage rescue situations, and active shooter incidents, or other criminal activity.
