Conduct a public hearing and consider an ordinance amending Chapter 13 of the City Code thereby updating the regulations regarding various temporary sign types, sign contractor registration and bonds, monument signs, purpose of the Code, noncommercial messages, bandit signs, replacement of billboards, wall signs and window signs.

Several aspects of the Sign Code are proposed for amendment. There are many types of temporary signs currently in the Code. Most of these are proposed for amendment or elimination. Staff is also proposing to strengthen the Code for conformance with legal requirements. In addition, there are proposed changes regarding wall signs, window signs, replacement of billboards and the inclusion of regulations regarding bandit signs.

Recommended/Desired Action

Staff recommends approval of the proposed ordinance.
